This information will be forwarded to the Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) to expedite clearing in at Grand Manan or Saint John at the RKYC, and for the US Customs and Border Patrol (CBP) at Eastport, ME. In consideration of the Blue Water Sailing Club (BWSC) accepting this entry, and of the substantial volunteer efforts of the officers, directors, members and associated volunteer personnel of BWSC, the undersigned Captain/Owner agrees:

1. That I hereby waive and release any claim, including those for negligence, gross negligence or equivalent misconduct, I may in the future have against BWSC and its officers, incident to the conduct of the BWSC 2014 July 4th North event.

2. If any provision of the agreement were deemed unenforceable, such shall not affect the enforceability of the remaining provisions of this agreement. This agreement shall be construed and enforced under the laws of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.
